Prior to graduation, all students are required to complete at least one WI course in the major at the 300-level or above. **Guidelines for WI courses** include:

- 1) WI sections are limited to 35 students;
- 2) students are required to submit at least 3,500 words of graded writing (about 14 standard double-spaced pages);
- 3) students must receive substantive feedback on at least one paper and will be given the opportunity to revise following feedback; and
- 4) in the case of collaborative assignments, each student must demonstrate that he/she has written individually at least 3000 words of the collaborative report.
