Prior to graduation, all students are required to complete at least one WI course in the major at the 300-level or above. **Guidelines for WI courses** include:

- 1) WI sections are limited to 35 students;
- 2) Faculty will devote significant time to instruction on writing in the course and on how to complete assignments successfully.
- 3) Students are required to revise at least one substantive assignment in the course based on instructor feedback.
- 4) Students will receive instructor feedback on their writing.
- 5) All of the writing assignments in the course should count substantially toward the students' final grade in the course. To this end, students should be asked to write a minimum of 3500 words, divided among two or more assignments.
- 6) In the case of collaborative assignments, each student must demonstrate that he/she has written individually at least 3000 words of the collaborative report.
- 7) WI Courses must be offered and taken in the major, unless an exception has been made by the WAC Committee.

The WI designation and writing requirements should be clearly noted on the syllabus. WI courses must also be clearly designated in the catalog description for the major. See a full explanation of the WI requirement on the WAC website: http://wac.gmu.edu/program/wi_requirement/
